## Vocabulary

- Equator: an imaginary line around the center of the world that divides the globe into the Northern and Southern Hemispheres.
- North Pole: the northern point at which Earth rotates on its axis.
- South Pole: the southern point at which Earth rotates on its axis.
- Coast: the land that runs along an ocean or gulf.
- Desert: dry land that gets little moisture.
- Prairie: a large area of level or gently rolling grasslands.
- Valley: a long expanse of lowland lying between hills or mountains.
- Ocean: a large body of salt water, covering most of the Earth.
